Project Illuminated brings together experts in the **education technology, teacher development and cognitive neuroscience** to empower school education teachers with knowledge from neuroscience.

Funded by the European Union's ERASMUS+ Programme, the project runs from **December 2017 to June 2020** and delivers **workshops** for school education teachers on the Science of Learning in Barcelona, Helsinki, Porto and Florina; a **MOOC** for educators; and holds a **teaching symposium** for educators in Barcelona in June 2020.

WHAT TO EXPECT



MAIN ACTIVITIES

- (1) <u>IlluminatED Educator Workshops</u> workshops for school education teachers on 'How memory works in the context of student learning' and 'Applying cognitive principles to learning design.'
- (3) <u>IlluminatED Teaching MOOC</u> based on the educator workshops and available to school education teachers worldwide.
- (2) <u>IlluminatED Trainers' Toolkit</u> resources and materials for educational trainers to support them in the delivering the IlluminaTED Educator Workshops.
- (4) <u>IlluminatED Teaching Symposium</u> a gathering hosted in Barcelona for educators that featuring presentations by experts.
